## Single Sort Recycling Instructions



### Plastic

Plastic bottles, containers, tubs and lids smaller than 3 gallons (#1, #2, #5)

### Containers

Aluminum, steel, tin cans  
Beer, wine, liquor bottles  
Food jars  
Glass jars  
Pie tins

### Paper

Brown grocery bags  
Cardboard, flattened  
Cereal, cracker, pasta boxes  
Dairy and juice cartons  
Electronics boxes  
Foil containers  
Mail, office & school paper  
Magazines, catalogs  
Newspapers and inserts  
Phone books  
Pop and beer boxes  
Shoe boxes, gift boxes

### DO NOT INCLUDE

Auto, mirror or tinted glass  
Batteries  
Blueprints, transparencies  
Carbon paper  
Carpeting  
Clothing  
Hazardous waste or containers  
Crystal glassware  
Disposable diapers  
Egg carton boxes  
Light bulbs  
Metal or steel objects such as nails, wire, hangers or case strapping  
Paper towels, napkins, tissue  
Pet-soiled paper  
Photos, photographic paper  
Plastic bags  
Pyrex, heat-resistant ovenware  
Rubber-type materials, latex  
Self-adhesive labels  
Shredded paper  
Styrofoam  
Toys  
Wax coated boxes

### IMPORTANT...

Rinse food from containers  
Break down large items

### Cardboard

Flatten cardboard & boxes  
Cardboard boxes should be flattened and placed in the container. Please, no trash.
